## Word Match

An international distress call used by ships and aircraft
A event featuring a series of boat races
The ability to float
A short pole with a flat blade on one or both ends used to propel a kayak, canoe or dragon boat
Propel a boat such as a kayak or canoe with the person facing forward.
A lightweight boat that is pointed on both ends and propelled by a double-bladed paddle
A long pole with a flat blade on one end used to propel a rowing shell
Work together, sharing thoughts and building on each other's ideas
A flat, floating board that a paddler stands or kneels on
A long canoe that seats 10 to 20 people and features a dragon head and tail
A personal flotation device
A lightweight boat that is pointed on both ends and propelled by an oar
A floating platform that can be constructed of a variety of materials
Propel a boat using oars, usually with the people going "backwards"
Taking something that already exists and coming up with ways to change it for the better
A lightweight boat where the paddler either sits or kneels and uses a single-pladed paddle
